Please Note – To show in the TGCA classes horses can be dual registered. If your horse is GVHS registered, they can easily be TGCA registered before the show or the day of.

Cost: All Breed & TGCA Classes

Pee Wee/Youth/Open - Pre-register before July 1st, 2023 - \$16.00 per class or \$150.00 for all/any classes.

Pee Wee/Youth/Open - Post Entries - \$21.00 per class or \$170.00 for all classes.

PRIZES and CHAMPIONSHIP awards:

- Prizes will be awarded to each 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner per class for both AB and TGCA Classes.
- Ribbons will be awarded up to the 5th place per class.
- Buckles will also be awarded in some classes.
- Additional cash prizes will be awarded in some classes.

River Lane Ranch Important Show Details

ENTRY FEES:

- You can pre-register up until July 1, 2023.
 Registration & waiver may be emailed to River
 Lane Ranch or dropped off at the ranch and must
 be accompanied by payment. Payment can be
 made by cash, or email money transfer. Please
 don't forget to add the GST.
- Pre entry \$16.00 per class \$150.00 for any/all
- Entries received after July 1st, 2023, will be considered post entries.
- Post entry \$21.00 per class or \$170.00 any/all
- Exhibitors may show more than one horse. One registration form per horse (extra applicable show fees per extra horse)
- TGCA Gypsy Cob horses may also show in All Breed classes
- Any part bred Gypsy horses, drums etc may show in the All-Breed classes.
- All Gypsy Cob horses must be registered with the TGCA. This can be done prior to the show or on the day of the show if required. Traditional Gypsy Cobs can have a dual registry and it's okay if they are already GVHS registered or registered with another registry, they just must have a TGCA registration also.
- Evaluations are held Saturday, July 8th from 9:00 am – 11:00 am. You must pre-register for this.
- Secretary's table opens at 8:00 AM. Located in the gazebo next to the outdoor arena.

All Breed & TGCA SHOWRULES:

- The judge's decision is final.
- The TGCA judges from the UK are qualified to judge the TGCA Gypsy Cobs & the All-Breed classes.
- The TGCA show committee reserves the right to alter, combine, split, or cancel classes or entries without prior notice with a full refund when/if required.
- Appropriate dress for English and Western classes is required (hat/helmet, long sleeves and riding boots are mandatory). Working condition tack acceptable.
- Please clean up after your horse, inside & outside of the arena.
- Horse abuse will not be tolerated.
- Stallions cannot be handled or shown by anyone under the age of 18 years.
- We strongly advise that all youth wear helmets (see waiver).

 Horses and/or riders posing a danger to themselves, or others will be asked to leave the arena and/or premises by the judge or show committee.

OTHER:

- The show will take place in the 200' x 100' outdoor arena.
- There will be no rain out date for the show as our judges are coming from England. The show must go on, rain or shine! We may alter classes if needed due to rain or move inside to our indoor arena if able.
- Please be mindful and kind when parking. If you need help, please reach out to ask.
- Water available for horses near outside wash bay at the barn.
- Wash bay is available.
- Viewing area available and all spectators are welcome!
- Overnight stalls available. Please call email (info@riverlaneranch.com) to book ahead as space is limited (Cost per night: \$30).
- Must supply your own feed/hay and water pails.
- Inside the RLR barn is private and no public access is available during the show or afterwards.
- There is no power or dumping on site so please bring generators if required for overnight haul ins.
- Stalls/bedding to be booked directly with River Lane Ranch please email info@riverlaneranch.com
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Owners must pick up after their dogs, anyone found not doing so will be fined \$20.00.
- Emptying out of trailers onto the property is forbidden. Please ensure you pick up droppings and loose hay before you depart and leave the parking area clean and tidy.
- Neither the organizers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of RLR or the TGCA accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
- A barn dance on Saturday night will begin at 7:30 pm. There is no additional cost, and all horse show attendees and spectators are welcome.

WARNING: BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU PROMISE NOT TO SUE FOR ANY INJURY OR DAMAGES HOWSOEVER CAUSED.

To: River Lane Ranch (hereinafter referred to collectively as "RLR") and employees, officers, and agents (hereinafter referred to collectively as "RLR employees").

"Equine activities" at or organized by "RLR" shall include any horse related activity that a person participates in or is a spectator of, including, but not limited to: riding, arena or trail lessons, cattle penning, roping, barrel racing, clinics, shows or gymkhanas, day camps, boarding, leasing, breeding, training, horse sales, group programs.

"Inherent risks" of equine activities shall mean those dangers or conditions, which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to:

- 1. The propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity.
- 2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals.
- 3. The equine's response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects.
- 4. Collisions with other equines, animals, people and/or objects.
- 5. The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability.

- 1 I agree as a precondition to my participation in an "equine activity" organized by "RLR" and conducted by "RLR" and/or "RLR employees", and in further consideration of "RLR" allowing me to do so, to be strictly bound by the terms of the Waiver, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "The Agreement").
- 2 I acknowledge that "equine activities" involve INHERENT RISKS that may cause SERIOUS INJURY AND POSSIBLY DEATH TO PARTICIPANTS.
- 3. I fully understand the risks and dangers associated with my participation in this "equine activity" and ACCEPT SAME ENTIRELY AT MY OWN RISK. I also understand that while participating in this high-risk sport, it is STRONGLY ADVISED by "RLR" and "RLR employees" to use appropriate safety equipment, including a HELMET with fixed harness, and require such use by a minor participant. Any failure or refusal to use such equipment shall be strictly at the participant's own risk.

- 4. I hereby WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS which I may have, now or in the future, against "RLR" and "RLR" employees" and release "RLR" and "RLR employees" from ALL LIABILITY for injury, death, property damage or any other loss sustained by me as a result of by participation in this "equine activity" DUE TO ANY CAUSE WHATSOEVER including, without limitation, negligence on the part of "RLR" or "RLR employees". I further AGREE TO INDEMNIFY "RLR" and "RLR" employees" for any and all legal fees (on a solicitor and his own client basis) or losses or costs which may be incurred in defending any lawsuit or claim I may bring against them.
