Join us in your finest dress attire for an evening of TGCA Special Evaluations and have your horse certified and graded by the TGCA evaluation judges!

The TGCA Directors and chief Judge have been surrounded by the Gypsy Cob breed their entire lives. We promise if you're looking for an official stamp that knows this breed better than anyone else, the TGCA is the best of the best!

How does it work?

Bring your Gypsy Cob (stallion, mare, yearling or mare/foal) to RLR the evening of June 7th, 2024. You and your horse will have time in the ring with the judges.

Each handler can expect to be in the ring approximately 15-20mins.

Once evaluations are completed you will receive a grading certificate.

At the end of the evening, Evaluators will choose ONE Grand Champion of all the horses they were presented throughout the night.

Will it be yours?

Dress in your best evening attire as this is a Gala event and you and your horses should be looking immaculate.

ENTRY FEES:

- •You can pre-register up until June 1, 2024. Registration & waiver may be emailed to River Lane Ranch or dropped off at the ranch and must be accompanied by payment. Payment can be made by cash, or email money transfer. Please don't forget to add the GST.
- •Pre entry \$16.00 per class \$150.00 for any/all
- •Entries received after June 1st, 2024, will be considered post entries.
- •Post entry \$21.00 per class or \$170.00 any/all
- •Exhibitors may show more than one horse. One registration form per horse (extra applicable show fees per extra horse)
- •Gypsy Cob horses may also show in All Breed classes.
- •Any part bred Gypsy horses, drums, etc may show in the All-Breed classes.
- •Evaluations are held Friday, June 7th beginning at 7:00 PM. You must pre-register for this. Discounts apply for those who have had their herd evaluations done for the Assured Breeders Scheme.
- Secretary's table opens at 8:00 AM Saturday and Sunday. Located in the gazebo next to the outdoor arena.

All BREED & TGCA SHOW RULES:

- •The judge's decision is final.
- •The TGCA judges from the UK will judge the TGCA Gypsy Cob classes and Carla Johnson from the USA will judge the All-Breed classes.
- •The TGCA show committee reserves the right to alter, combine, split, or cancel classes or entries without prior notice with a full refund when/if required.

English Riding classes:

•Appropriate dress for English classes is required. All tack must be English from the saddle, saddle pad and bridle. Bits should be a simple snaffle, pelham or double bridle. Brassin-hand bridles are not to be used in ridden classes. Judges may take into consideration the severity of the bit, their opinions on suitable bridles may vary and their decision is final.

Western Riding Classes:

 Appropriate dress for Western classes is required (hat/helmet, long sleeves and riding boots are mandatory). Working condition tack acceptable. Breast collars are okay.

In hand Showing:

- •Fillies and mares can be shown in either a show halter.
- •Yearling colts (as of 1st January of the current year) may be shown in a halter. Foals born in the current year (as of 1st January) are to be shown in either a simple show halter or a leather in hand halter or foal slip - NO BITS.
- •Colts/stallions aged three years and over MUST be shown in and spectators are welcome. a stallion bridle or a leather halter with a chain.
- •The use of a stallion harness is permitted on stallions over the age of four. The judge may ask that the side reins are unclipped when in the class.
- •Please clean up after your horse, inside & outside of the arena.
- •All inhumane treatment of animals will not be tolerated.
- •Stallions cannot be handled or shown by anyone under the age of 18 years.

- •We strongly advise that all youth wear helmets (see waiver).
- •Horses and/or riders posing a danger to themselves, or others will be asked to leave the arena and/or premises by the judge or show committee.
- *All RLR representatives shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation and respect and no person shall direct abusive or threatening conduct toward them at any time.
- *Management reserves the right to refuse any entry.

- •The show will take place in the 200' x 100' outdoor arena.
- •There will be no rain out date for the show as our judges are coming from England and the USA. The show must go on, rain or shine! We may alter classes if needed due to rain or move inside to our indoor arena if able.
- Please be mindful and kind when parking. If you need help, please reach out to ask.
- · Water is available for horses near the outside wash bay at the barn.
- Wash bay is available.
- •Viewing area available and all spectators are welcome!
- •Limited overnight outdoor and/or indoor stalls available. Please email (horseshow@riverlaneranch.com) to book ahead as space is limited (Cost is \$30.00 per night, per horse).
- •Must supply your own feed/hay and water pails.
- Inside the RLR barn is private and no public access is available during the show or afterwards.
- There is no power or dumping on site so please bring generators if required for overnight haul ins.
- There is no charge for camping/overnight stays.
- •Stalls/bedding to be booked directly with River Lane Ranch please email horseshow@riverlaneranch.com
- •Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times. Owners must pick up after their dogs, anyone found not doing so will be fined \$20.00.
- •Emptying out of trailers onto the property is forbidden. Please ensure you pick up droppings and loose hay before you depart and leave the parking area clean and tidy.
- •Neither the organizers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of RLR or the TGCA accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
- •An outdoor barn dance on Saturday night will begin at 8:00 pm. There is no additional cost, and all horse show attendees

To: River Lane Ranch (hereinafter referred to collectively as "RLR") and employees, officers, and agents (hereinafter referred to collectively as "RLR employees").

"Equine activities" at or organized by "RLR" shall include any horse related activity that a person participates in or is a spectator of, including, but not limited to: riding, arena or trail lessons, cattle penning, roping, barrel racing, clinics, shows or gymkhanas, day camps, boarding, leasing, breeding, training, horse sales, group programs.

"Inherent risks" of equine activities shall mean those dangers or conditions, which are an integral part of equine activities, including, but not limited to:

- 1. The propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them and/or damage to property in their vicinity.
- 2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals.
- 3. The equine's response to certain hazards such as surface and subsurface objects.
- 4. Collisions with other equines, animals, people and/or objects.
- 5. The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or to act within his or her ability.
