The good news is that the ranch is very relaxed, casual, and comfortable. You do NOT need fancy clothes, expensive western wear, or anything formal. We are a real working ranch, and most of our days are spent around horses, dogs, family, and plenty of fresh air.

IMPORTANT: Don't Forget Your Passport

For our guests traveling from the United States or internationally, please make sure your passport is valid and packed in your carry-on luggage.

You will need it to enter Canada.

Clothing

We recommend dressing comfortably and in layers.

Jeans & shorts

Comfortable shirts and t-shirts

Hoodies and sweatshirts

Light jacket

Sweats or comfortable lounge clothes for evenings

If Riding:

Cowboy boots OR boots with a small heel

(Please do not bring running shoes for riding)

Riding jeans or comfortable jeans

Footwear

This year has been considerably wetter than normal, and depending on weather conditions, some areas of the ranch may be muddy.

We strongly recommend bringing:

Muck boots or Rubber boots

These are often the most-used footwear on the ranch when conditions are wet.

- ✗ Expensive handbags
- ✗ Anything formal
